If a wireless network is desired, we recommend using a wireless 'N' access point.

* **PLEASE NOTE:** Systems with Windows Vista Business or Windows 7 Pro may also function as a server, but a designated server with redundant drives for data protection and overall system reliability is strongly recommended. Licenses should be purchased for the number of users/devices. 5 CALs standard with Windows Server 2003.

Other Important System Requirements

1. With a server OS, each Client Machine/Device needs to have a client license from Microsoft and depending on the network you may need to purchase additional licenses. *(5 client licenses come included with Server 2003)*
2. Windows Server 2003, 2008, XP Pro (SP3), Windows Vista Business and Windows 7 Pro can be used as the server operating system. *Windows UAC will need to be disabled on all Vista and Windows 7 machines.*
3. The server must be connected to the network router/hub with a wired connection.
4. **NOTICE TO TECHNICIAN:** Once the network is set up, a folder named "VOS" must be created on the root of the server's main data volume (i.e., "C:\VOS" or "D:\VOS:"). This folder must be shared to all network client machines and mapped on each client workstation as the V: drive.

Internet and LAN/WLAN Network Requirements

You must have a high-speed Internet connection to receive installation, updates, training, and support. VOS will not function correctly without this connection.

VOS is a Client/Server application so it needs a secure and stable network. Wired networks work best for this. If you choose to use a wireless network, ensure that your network is secured and free from outside interference that may impede the stability of your network. **Future Health, Inc. recommends that you hire a professional, certified IT specialist to install and evaluate your wireless network for stability before installing VOS.**
